Next month is our annual Reformation Celebration here at Providence. In preparing for this year's events, let us pray for Luther's homeland and the things God is doing there today.

Heart Cry (heartcrymissionary.com) recently reported encouraging signs of a work of the Spirit of God that point to another possible reformation. God, who causes the light to shine out of darkness, is shining in that dark region of the world to birth faith and conviction in the lives of many young men and women.

Germany is known for its spiritual deadness and apostasy, but God appears to be raising up a new generation whose supreme passion is the glory of God. Many of the things that were evident in Luther's time as preludes to the *Protestant Reformation* are appearing today with resounding reality.
