Bermuda is 181 small islands in the North Atlantic. It is about 640 miles east of Cape Hatteras, NC and 770 miles south of Nova Scotia. The world's most northerly coral reefs and the third most-densely populated country. The population is 64,995. Thanks to the Gulf Stream it has a tropical climate.

Bermuda's economy is based on offshore insurance and reinsurance, and tourism. The language is English.

The largest religion is Christian, about 90% of the population. Of those about 16% is evangelical.

Prayer Challenges: The church's impact is blunted by a failure to work together as much as is possible.

The good news is that recently a large fellowship of mostly evangelical pastors has formed. Their goal is to make prayer a priority among believers and to serve as a united voice on moral issues.
